



Where to Hike in Hixon Forest?

Easy Hiking – few if any hills

Sumac trail to Bicentennial trail (ending at meadow)	0.70 miles
Sumac trail & Lower Fern trail (comes out at meadow)	0.75 miles

Moderate Hiking – a few, moderate hills

Sumac trail & Upper Fern trail (comes out near meadow)	0.95 miles
Sumac trail & Hickory trail to Bicentennial trail & down to meadow	1.75 miles
Sumac trail to Bicentennial trail and Log trail loop	1.80 miles

More Difficult Hiking – steep slopes leading to top of bluff

Sumac trail & Lookout Trail to Lookout Point	1.40 miles
Sumac trail & Bicentennial trail (ending on Hwy FA on top of bluff)	1.60 miles

Other Areas to Hike

Easy Hiking – few if any hills

Nature's Edge trail (self-guided interpretive trail near Nature Center)	0.60 miles
Wood Duck trail (go under hwy 16 by Boy Scouts to Myrick Park)	0.40 miles
Main loop of R.A.B.B.I.T. trail in La Crosse River Marsh	1.30 miles
